Scholarship Announcement

Enclosed are announcements and applications from the Sacramento City Teachers Association for this year's Regular High School Scholarship. There are other scholarships available annually. Please contact SCTA at (916)452-4591 for further details. The Sacramento City Teachers Association will be awarding at least one scholarship to a student from one of the District's High Schools who fulfills the requirements. Recipients should have a strong academic record, recommendations, demonstrate need, goals, activities, and fulfill the following requirements:

- 1) Senior graduating from a SCUSD high school during the 2009-10 school year.
- 2) At least one year enrollment at present school.
- 3) Proof of registration in at least 12 units of class work at any two or four year accredited institution of higher learning or equivalent vocational program in the fall or spring of subsequent year.
- 4) Minimum academic GPA of 3.0 Required.
- 5) Application must be accompanied by a school photo.

The Scholarship award is \$2,000.00. Students with an SCTA parent receive additional points. Please circulate these letters and applications to any student who may fit the above description. Please submit the proper application form and attach an **OFFICIAL** (with Registrar's Seal) transcript of high school credits (with GPA) through the first semester of this year. You will need to provide a clear statement of your needs and goals as an attachment.

Please have all materials (application, transcripts, and added statements) at the SCTA office **no later than April 15 at 5:00 p.m.** Applications and forms may be sent through school mail or U.S. Mail or they may be delivered to the SCTA office at 5300 Elvas Avenue. **Incomplete applications or applications received after the deadline ABSOLUTELY CANNOT be considered!**

If a candidate is chosen for a scholarship, a brief biography and school photo must be brought in to SCTA before a check can be issued. This will be used for an article in the District newspaper.
